



**Board of Aldermen Public Hearing Minutes
Tuesday, February 18, 2020 at 6:50 p.m.**

Mayor Blum called the Public Hearing to order at 6:50 p.m.

Present were Mayor Blum, Alderman Art Viehland, Alderman Janet Viehland, Alderman Jamie Frossard, Alderman Amanda Sikes and Attorney Voss. Administrator Dierker arrived just after roll call at 6:50 p.m.

Mayor Blum explained this public hearing is in regard to amending certain provisions of the city code regarding self-storage units.

Alderman Art Viehland said this zoning change takes the self-storage out of the commercial zones which can be used as store fronts instead of storage units. He said it places them in light industrial with a conditional use and will free up our commercial properties for other businesses such as retail.
