- 3. <u>2009 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project Bid Opening</u> The Mayor shall open and read aloud sealed bids for the 2009 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project. To date, three contractors have requested bid documents and discussed the project with City officials.
- 4. Administration Office Hours: The Board of Alderman to discuss and possibly approve a request from Alderman Marrocco to change the Administrative Office hours at City Hall from 8 to 5 p.m., with administrative employees receiving an hour lunch, to 8 to 4: 30 p.m. closing from noon to 12:30 p.m. for lunch. - 1. <u>Bill 2009-25:</u> An ordinance for the voluntary annexation of certain adjacent property owned and operated by United Methodist Church, Rivers of Life Worship Center, St. Clair IDA, Joseph and Sandra Stecher, Frank and Betty Reed, and the Victory Church of St. Clair into the City of St. Clair. If passed, Bill 2009-25 becomes Ordinance 1537.
- 2. <u>Bill 2009-26</u>: An ordinance authorizing the City Administrator to enter into a Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission Transportation Enhancement Funds Supplemental Agreement that authorizes the distribution of Non-Attributable Federal Aid Funds to the City of St. Clair in the amount of \$33,962 to be used for the reimbursement of local monies utilized in the completion of the Main Street Project. If passed, Bill 2009-26 becomes Ordinance 1538.
- 3. <u>Resolution 2009-10</u>: A resolution establishing a Fraud Detection Program and creating a Finance Audit Committee to provide independent oversight of the City's financial records. The adoption of this program by the Board of Alderman will complete 91% of the Independent Auditor's recommendations.
