Roll Call: City Clerk called the roll. Present were Mayor Blum, Administrator Dierker, Alderman J. Viehland, Alderman McGlenn, Alderman A. Viehland, Alderman Talleur and Attorney Voss.

1. City Administrator-Travis Dierker:

a. Airport Update: The hangar tenants have been given notice of the tentative date for closure which is scheduled for November 1st. He said he has another call scheduled with MODot regarding salvageable items later this week.

b. Signs: The city has to work towards getting all signs switched over to a retro reflectivity standard that must be met. He said part of doing that there are traffic engineering assistant program grants available. He said we have partnered with a firm – Access Engineering out of St. Louis and signed on with them for a small fee of \$550 to get the application completed and hopefully we will receive funding up to \$10,000 for sign inventory and sign purchases.

Administrator Dierker said he has asked them when

they are running trains to possibly adjust schedules and not run trains that are loud during the middle of the night.
