Release and Waiver –

Please read the following and sign below if you accept its terms:

- In consideration of my participation, I hereby release City of St. Clair Parks & Recreation, City of St. Clair, St. Clair Park Board, St. Clair IDA, its board members and officers, and any and all sponsors, volunteers or agents of the preceding from any present and future claims, including negligence, for property damage, personal injury, or wrongful death, arising from my or my child's participation in the above-described event.
- Furthermore, I hereby voluntarily waive any and all claims, both present and future, arising from my or my child's participation in the above-described activity, including but not limited to negligence, property damage, personal injury and wrongful death.
- I understand that racing or otherwise participation in the bike and/or power wheels race involves certain risks, including but not limited to, travel to and from the site of the event, severe physical contact, stress, heat-related injuries, dehydration, hypothermia, soft-tissue injuries, exhaustion and the possible reckless conduct of other participants. These risks also include but are not limited to death, serious neck and spinal injuries resulting in complete or partial paralysis, brain damage, and serious injury to virtually all bones, joints, muscles and internal organs.
- I further understand that the activities that my child or I participate in may be conducted at a site that is removed from available medical assistance; and nonetheless agree to proceed with such activities despite the possible absence of medical assistance. I also understand that any equipment provided for my protection may be inadequate in preventing serious injury.
- I specifically release and discharge said operators and sponsors from all injuries or damages arising from or contributed to by any physical impairment or defect I may have, whether latent or patent, and agree that they are under no obligation to provide a physical examination or other evidence of my physical fitness to participate in such event the same being my sole responsibility.
- I also give permission for the free use of my name and picture in any media, social media, advertisement, or written account of the event.

I have read this form and fully understand that by signing this form, I am giving up legal rights and/or remedies which may be available to me or my child.

You can email the information to office2@stclairmo.us and be sure to place your child's name in the subject line so we know which entry it goes with, if more than one child will have to send each child's email separate.

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Power Wheels Race: The following brands are permitted and recommended: Power Wheels, Peg Perego, and Little Tikes. This includes any current or former Fisher-Price brand Power Wheels, as well as Little Tikes Ride On toys. Any vehicle that is not of these brands will be subject to review but will most likely be completely fine. All vehicles in the event must be controlled and steered by one human driver seated in the vehicle (NO remotely controlled vehicles are allowed). If your car is deemed as not qualifying or unsafe, don't get upset with officials, as they are putting the safety and fairness first. Officials decisions are final.



- Race will be conducted as a hand drop race. When the hand drops you go.
- Chase is the race will be allowed, meaning that if one of the racers jumps and the other racer follows, it is a legitimate race. If the other racer doesn't move then they will be the winner, but if they move at all then they will be considered as chasing the other.
- Each racer will draw a chip from a bag and the racer who has that same number will be who you will race against. The winners from each race will then draw again until the last two.
- If your vehicle runs out of battery life or breaks down, you will have to forfeit your race. (Please note that the airport does not have electric so make sure that you have your batteries charged or that you have a battery back that can charge the vehicle if necessary.
- One team member (parent/guardian) will be allowed at the start line with their child and another team member will be allowed at the finish line if they wish.
- Officials determination of winners are **final** there will be no arguments or poor sportsmanship allowed.

Bicycle Race: Any type of non-motorized bike with pedals is welcome; BMX, mountain or other... All bicycles must have working brakes and be in good condition, if it is deemed unsafe you will not be able to race, safety is the number 1 priority.

- Bike races will be conducted as a hand drop race but will be in heats.
- We will divide these heats the day of the event based on bike/age (we have not decided yet, as we are unsure of the response we will have).
- One team member (parent/guardian) will be allowed at the start line with their child and another team member will be allowed at the finish line if they wish.

Bike & Power Wheels Race Requirements:

Helmets

- **Power Wheels Race Requirement:** A DOT approved motorcycle/racing helmet is required for all drivers. Your drivers can share helmets, but every driver **MUST** have this helmet. It is highly recommended to use a full-face helmet, but open face helmets are permitted. No damage on helmets.
- **Bicycle Race Requirement:** A DOT approved bicycle helmet is required for all those competing in bike race. Bicyclers may share helmets, but every cyclist must have a helmet.

Driver Attire

- **Power Wheels Race & Bicycle Race Requirement:** Any appendage or human part that is exposed to the elements must be protected effectively via protective gear such as knee pads and elbow pads/cloth or other. Closed toed shoes are required. We are not responsible for your willful ignorance to our incredibly heavy suggestions to protect yourself. Even at 2mph road rash can be nasty. Knee pads or elbow pads in conjunction with long pants and sleeves are also deeply, seriously, really recommended with **BIG BOLD** letters. Wear gloves as an added precaution.

****Please number each car/bike with a unique number somewhere on its body. The number shall be 1-5 digits long and the lettering shall be at least 1.5" tall. Remember if you obtain a sponsor for the event you should also place your sponsors information with your number you selected. For bikes it can be displayed off the front handle bars and for the Power Wheel Cars you can display it on the hood, doors, or front and back bumper.***

*Remember every race has its winners and losers. Since this is "racing" we are required by the racing gods to reward the folks who win, not everyone will receive an award. At the end of the races, the top three drivers will be recognized and receive awards.
